absolutely stunning PBs.

David Greig set a massive PB in his 1500m in a time of 3:54.8, this time is also a National Qualifier for David. This great run followed a race at Milers Club on the Tuesday prior where he had a time of 4:22.4 for the Mile.

Not to be completely outdone, father Barry set a season's best in his 3000m with a handy time of 10:49.0.

Then the girls really stood up!! Paige Bukovsan set a big PB in the Under 16, 1500m with a time of 5:07.2, a new Club Record. Previous record was held by Freya Henriiksen at 5:08.03 which was set in 2016. Then sister Kate took 37 seconds off her previous 3000m with a time of 12:53.3. Marli Brenner produced a fantastic 400m in 69.87 and Sami Rowe set a PB in the triple jump with a good 7.91m. This was a fantastic set of performances from the girls.

Jack Harper set a new PB in his 400m with 50.83, Finn Knight shaved a bit off his 400m PB with a 54.26, and then Josh Philip smashed his previous PB in the 1500m with a nice time of 4:10.8.

Everyone on the team performed close to or at their best. It was also great to see Charles Shea make it back from holidays to qualify for the Final on March 5th.

Total Team score was 8379 points, comfortably defeating Williamstown's score of 7210.

Our Under 20 Men's Group
