Our Men's team performed well placing third in the Division with a standout performance from young Harley Mileto breaking through the 35 minute barrier. Times were: David Greig 32.07, Harley Mileto 34.45, Claude Aquino 41.03, Barry Greig 43.29, Chris Branigan 47.53 and James Lynch 52.11.

This race was incredibly competitive and a huge field with David Greig coming very close to breaking the 32 minute barrier.

Australian Cross Country Championships

- 10km Open Men's cross country, Oakbank Racecourse SA, 27th August 2022.

David Greig competed in his first Australian Cross Country Championship on this picturesque racecourse, some 40kms from Adelaide. The course was 2km per lap with 5 laps or 10k for the seniors. It was a demanding track with winding sections through the centre of the racecourse and a long heavy hill at the back.

The day prior to the race, athletes could inspect the course, which many did, including coaches, officials and parents. On race day there were about 16 races prior to the main race so you can imagine the state of the course by the time the seniors ran after all of the traffic.

Barry Greig described the course as "in horse racing terms the course would be described as 'heavy', a grass surface that has received an extremely large amount of water and is in almost bog-like condition." Officials were seen retrieving spikes out of the mud after each race had passed through one section of the course!

David ran a good race finishing 30th in a time of 35:54, placing 10th in the Under 23 category. He had a strong start holding a steady pace throughout to maintain his position in the field and had a good finish. A great first up result at National level, congratulations David.
